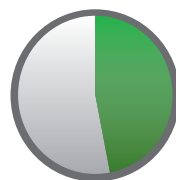
The 5,871 m² Stan Little Building is the new, LEED Gold headquarters for the Canadian Union of Public Employees (CUPE), the largest union in Canada. The health and well-being of Canadians is at the forefront of what CUPE members do. So, it is natural that the new national office is a shining example of a healthy building. This five-storey office

building includes a gym, conference room, staff offices, and a print shop.

Practicing what they preach in terms of valuing employees, CUPE's office includes the latest in energy and water efficiency measures and minimizes disruption to the surrounding landscape.

Notable Features

- Low-flow plumbing fixtures, including dual-flush toilets
- Drought-resistant landscaping to eliminate need for irrigation
- Energy recovery on ventilation system
- Occupancy and CO₂ sensors control lights and ventilation
- Rooftop solar panels save 60% of the energy used for heating water
- 31% of the construction materials extracted or manufactured locally
- Low off-gassing paints, sealants, adhesives, and coatings
- Green Label certified carpet
- Naturally-lit offices, views to the outdoors, and operable windows
