Featured Projects

Kingston Police Headquarters (Kingston, Ontario) – With Enermodal providing five sustainability services for this LEED Gold certified project, the facility is predicted to achieve 71% indoor water savings.

Vaughan Station No. 7-9/York Region EMS Response (Vaughan, Ontario) – This LEED Gold certified facility is a duplicate of a conventional facility except for its LEED features, such as demand-controlled ventilation and heat recovery, which resulted in 32% predicted energy savings over its counterpart.

Northampton Police Department (Northampton, Massachusetts) – The first building constructed under the City's sustainability plan, this LEED Silver candidate the police department building is a LEED Silver candidate.
