Fortunately, Enermodal has found that green values can merge seamlessly with elegance and comfort to create hospitable buildings worth visiting.

Featured Projects

E'Terra Ecolodge (Tobermory, Ontario) – One of the first buildings certified (Gold) under the LEED Canada green building rating system, this luxury lodge is located in a wood building with most lumber FSC certified and 40% of the materials from regional sources.

Ottawa Convention Centre (Ottawa, Ontario) – A LEED Silver candidate retrofit, this modern, 33,400m² facility features extensive stormwater management, efficient lighting, no onsite parking, and superior waste diversion. This project features 30 meeting spaces, a ballroom, kitchen, a 6,000-seat theatre, and a formal boardroom.

Washow Ecolodge (Moose Factory, Ontario) – This 12-bedroom wilderness lodge near James Bay includes 3 kW PV electric supply. Also, potable water (treated with an ultra-filtration system) is supplied by a local creek. Wastewater is treated by composting toilets and biofiltration.
