Featured Projects

Brookside Public School (Toronto, Ontario) – The figure-8 design of this LEED Gold school, permitted daylighting for interior classrooms. A state-of-the-art ventilation system includes displacement ventilation in classrooms and jet air diffusers in the gym and offices.

Connaught Community School (Calgary, Alberta) – This school includes an Enermodal Signature Green Education Kiosk helps students understand the green features of their school. Demand-controlled ventilation and natural cooling highlight an efficient mechanical system.

Dr. David Suzuki Public School (Windsor, Ontario) – Once certified, Suzuki PS will be the first LEED Platinum school in Canada thanks to its exemplary performance in energy efficiency and 95% construction waste landfill diversion.
